Neuromancer is a 1984 science fiction novel by American-Canadian writer William Gibson. It is one of the best-known works in the cyberpunk genre and the first novel to win the Nebula Award, the Philip K. Dick Award, and the Hugo Award. It was Gibson's debut novel and the beginning of the Sprawl trilogy. The Sprawl trilogy (also known as the Neuromancer, Cyberspace, or Matrix trilogy) is William Gibson's first set of novels, composed of Neuromancer (1984), Count Zero (1986), and Mona Lisa Overdrive (1988). Neuromancien (titre original : Neuromancer) est le premier roman de science-fiction de William Gibson. Publié en 1984, il est généralement considéré comme le roman fondateur du mouvement Cyberpunk, ayant inspiré bon nombre d'œuvres telles que les mangas Ghost in the Shell ou Akira et le film Matrix.
