This Oxford Shakespeare edition of Hamlet represents a radically new text of the best known and most widely discussed of all Shakespearean tragedies. The Tragedy of Hamlet, Prince of Denmark, often shortened to Hamlet (/ ʔ h æ m l ʔ t /), is a tragedy written by William Shakespeare at an uncertain date between 1599 and 1602. In the wake of his father's abrupt death, Hamlet returns home from university to find his personal and political world changed as he never imagined it could—his mother remarried, his uncle on the throne and a world seemingly gone insane.
