International Commercial Law is a body of legal rules, conventions, treaties, domestic legislation and commercial customs or usages, that governs international commercial or business transactions. A transaction will qualify to be international if elements of more than one country are involved. International contract law concerns the legal rules relating to cross-border agreements. When parties from different countries enter into a contract, they are governed by this type of law unless they agree to abide by the laws of one of the countries.
