Biodiversity Design. The majority of new woodland should be made up of native species but can include a proportion of non-native or advancing/honorary species: Williams Well Wood, Devon - About 2 ½ acres, £25,000. Sigford, Ashburton, Devon. An intriguing mature broadleaved woodland with historical mining features and good access links to Dartmoor National park. Coed Ffos Las, Carmarthenshire - 9 acres, £55,000. Trimsaran, Kidwelly, Carmarthenshire. Land of lovely varied habitat including some great specimens of mature oak, young mixed broadleaf woodland, a small pond and stream and open rough pasture with very good access directly off a minor road.
