The Password to Larkspur Lane is the tenth volume in the Nancy Drew Mystery Stories series. It was first published in 1933 under the pseudonym Carolyn Keene. The actual author was ghostwriter Walter Karig in his third and final Nancy Drew novel and his final appearance for the Stratemeyer Syndicate. Due to Karig passing away in 1956, this book and his other 2 Nancy Drews, as of January 1, 2007, have passed into the public domain in Canada and other countries with a life plus 50 policy. Password to Larkspur Lane is a children's story by Carolyn Keene (pseudonym) and the 10th book in the Nancy Drew series. A mysterious signal and a message alert Nancy to the plight of an elderly woman who is being held prisoner. While Nancy and her friends attempt to rescue the woman, they uncover a dangerous ring of swindlers. The only clue to her identity is a bracelet with a family crest, and the doctor's belief that she was being held on Larkspur Lane.
