Summary

The Long Valley is a collection of short stories written by the American author John Steinbeck. The collection was first published in 1938. It comprises 12 short stories. The short stories were written over several years and are set in Steinbeck's birthplace, the Salinas Valley in California. Steinbeck also reveals Peter disappears for a week once a year on a "business trip," after which, upon his return, Emma takes to her sick bed for a month or two (77). One particular fall, Emma takes to her sick bed for the last time and dies after "a long, terrible illness" (80).
